The Demonstration: Ted Smith provided the demo on short notice, as Clif was not able to come. Ted had been to a commercial woodturning shop (Wooden Nickel) when in southwest Oregon and noted that they use only one type of tool which is a double ended scraper on a ½” square bar (rounded on one end and square on the other – see photo below). The cycle time on turning the goblet (chalice) is about 15 minutes each, and sell for ~\$43 each. He demonstrated how they turn a goblet with the one tool, and passed around the photos of the shop.
