John adjourned the meeting about 8:20 pm.

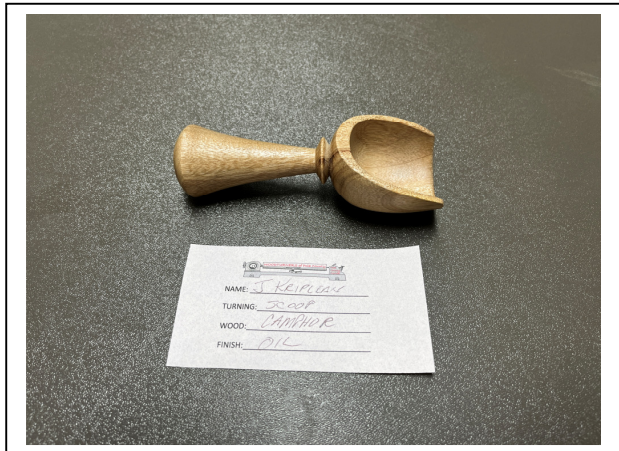

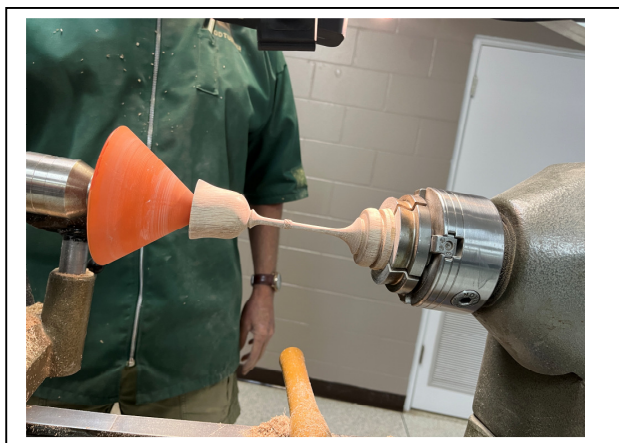

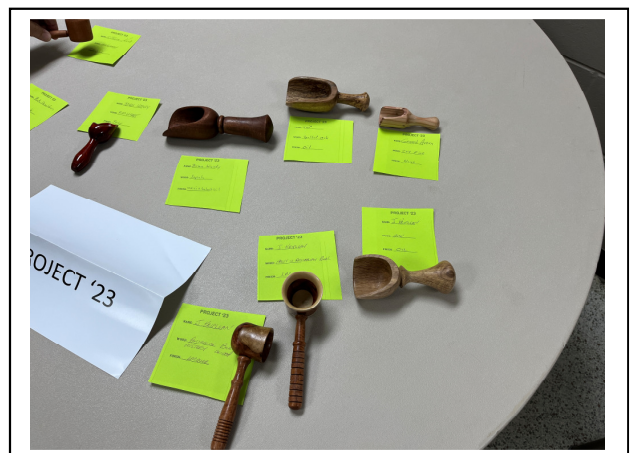
