



Wood Turners of Polk County May 15, 2021 Meeting Minutes

John Kriplean (VP) called the meeting to order around 10:05 AM at the Steve Hoods shop. There were about 17 in attendance including 2 on Zoom. The meeting date, time and location continues at Steve Hood's shop due to the impact on the C-19 virus and the need to be in fresh air (not in a closed building). New rules on Covid -19 allow better meeting conditions.

Ted gave the treasures report - \$ 5,426 on hand at the start of the meeting. 3 members paid their dues.

The club voted to approve a new club policy of considering any item that is brought to the meeting that the person is giving permission to the club and attendees to photograph the item and publish the photo in the club minutes and on the web, and the photos are not covered by copyright.
