Demonstration

Ted Smith demonstrated using the McNaughton system to core bowl blanks. Ted talked about the various systems that are available (McNaughton, OneWay Easy Core & Wood cut). Ted also used his home made McNaughton type tool for one of the coring. The key point is that there is a learning curve and the systems are expensive – not worth it for occasional bowls. Ted showed how he sets up the location and angle of the McNaughton knife to get the desired cut – See photo of sketch. Note this works best on green wood that is not fibrous.

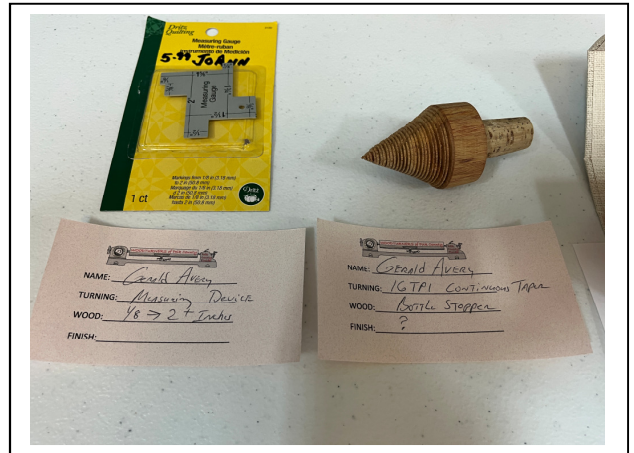

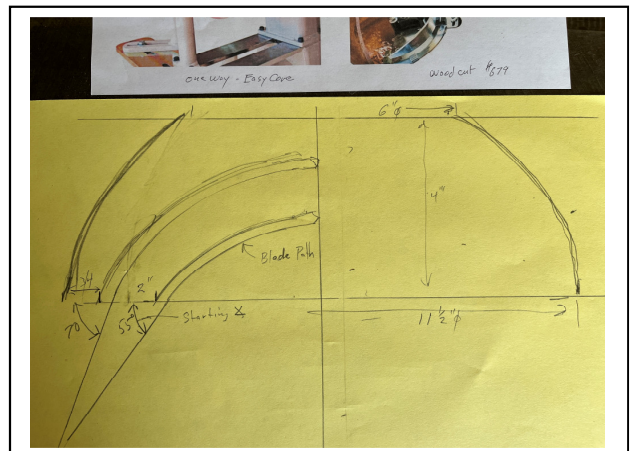

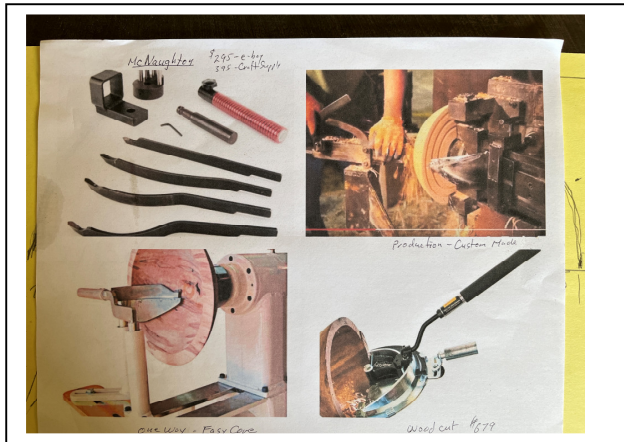
