Demonstration

Ted Smith demonstrated how to turn 2 types of scoops – coffee and a two piece salt scoop. The coffee scoop is made of two parts – the cup is turned to desired shape and the handle separately. The two are glued using a 3/8" tenon. For the salt scoops, the two halves are glued only in the chuck tenon section and in the middle of the scoop (part that will be hollowed out. The scoop portion outside is turned and sanded to final size, the wrapped with tape/string to hold together while hollowing and turning handle. When the handle is cut free, then the two scoops are completed and the tape and string removed. Final sanding can be done with a dremel tool or by hand.

Mike Linkswiler, announced that next month's Project '23 challenge is to turn a scoop.

Mike Linkswiler adjourned the meeting about 8:30 pm.


