



## Wood Turners of Polk County October 14, 2010 Meeting Minutes

John Kriplean called the meeting to order around 7:05 PM at the Bartow Civic Center. There were 14 in attendance.

**Announcements:** **Noted** Florida State Fair sign up is on line (sign up by Dec 15, Items to be in by Jan 26, 2011). **Discussed** the Florida Symposium this next year will be on Feb 4-6. **Rich Horton** will be having a woodworking club meeting at his shop on Nov. 4, demonstrating inside out turning. Club members are welcome.

The 50/50 raffle of \$5.50 was won by Adam Hood.

The Christmas party was discussed, and the members agreed to have the item raffle like last year. Ted will obtain similar items for the raffle.

The club approved John Kriplean to buy a DVD on working with acrylic.

**Demonstrations scheduled** are: November –Al Hockenbery will be demonstrating bowl turning basics. The December meeting is the annual Christmas party December 9, at Ling's – 6 PM.

### Show and Tell:

<b>Rick Horton</b>	Bowl from pine lighter wood knot – started it at the last sawdust session.
<b>John Kriplean</b>	Two matching boxes on stand (walnut with paduka stands). A box of pens, letter openers (see photos). Very nice
<b>Jim Boatwright</b>	Lamp post made from section of Norfolk island pine. Very nice.
<b>Tracy</b>	Small bowl – gum? Very nice
<b>Ted</b>	Bowl from boards (ash, walnut and ??), and small vase (crape myrtle)

**The Demonstration:** Ron Cinquanti, turning a paper weights. The paper weights start with a ~1" thick block about 3" dia. Ron drills a 1" hole in the bottom with a forstner bit, and uses the hole to mount the disk on a #2MT wooden jam block in the head stock. After turning the shape, he jammed it in a wooden jam chuck to work the face and reversed it to work the bottom. Ron turned a plug disk to seal the bottom, after filling the cavity with BB's to give it weight. See photos of different top treatments.
